

# Smart-fab<sup>®</sup> Artiste Aprons

## All Grade levels

Lesson Plan by Edwin Leary, Art Consultant, Florida

## Description

Smart-fab's bold brilliant colors are in the material itself. A soft pliable cloth like texture, yet a strong and durable fabric. Smart-fab won't rip or fray and is water resistant. It's easy to cut, sew, fold, twist, crimp, ruffle and glue. It can be easily colored with acrylic paints, markers, crayons, oil pastels and most art media. Smart-fab is recyclable, easy to store, and cost effective.

## Objectives

Students will employ their skills and techniques in the construction of an Artiste Apron using Smart-fab. Students are inherently experiential and will actively explore art processes and media to produce a creative art work, a functional art apron.



## Directions

1. Review materials and characteristics of Smart-fab: Can be sewn, glued, colored/painted upon, etc. **Note: cannot be ironed with any heat setting.**
2. Choose color and size of Smart-fab rolls. The 48"x 40' roll will make 13 aprons, each approximately 24" wide at the base and 33" long.
3. Cut an apron pattern out of a large sheet of paper, 24" wide by 33" long. Sketch and cut pattern to the apron size of 24" wide by 33" long with the upper part being curved towards the neck. Cut three 2" x 24" strips to be used for neck loop and apron ties. In addition, cut a 7" x 10" rectangle for a pocket.
4. Cut Smart-fab according to pattern (Can purchase See & Sew Pattern #B4585 from any craft store): apron, ties, neck loop and pocket.
5. Decide on method of assembly, sewing or gluing. If gluing, use Tacky Glue.
6. Fold, sew or glue a selvedge edge hem of ½" around apron and pocket for added strength and durability. Glue 6" - 8" lengths at a time for better control. Use masking tape to secure in place while glue dries.
7. Fold. Sew or glue apron ties and neck loop to a finished size of 1' x 24", use masking tape to secure in place while glue dries.
8. Final assembly: glue apron ties, neck loop and pocket onto apron.

## Decorating:

Test acrylic paints, markers, oil pastels for drying time and color on excess Smart-fab.
